#### **CHANGING ROOMS**

Changing rooms will be provided in the stadium.

#### WARM UP AREA

#### **DOPING CONTROL**

The NADA will carry out doping controls according to the "WA Anti-Doping Regulations" (in force as from 1st January, 2025) and according to the rules on the WA homepage: <u>https://worldathletics.org/about-iaaf/documents/book-of-rules</u>. **Please make sure to bring a valid ID for your identification.** 

#### **COMPETITION CONTROLS**

After every competition, selected athletes will be informed to attend the doping procedures.

### **RECORD CONTROLS**

For world or area records, a doping test is mandatory. In the case of a national record, testing is only required if requested by the national federation. In such cases, the responsibility lies with the athlete and/or the team officials, and the costs of the doping control must be covered by the athlete or their federation.

### CALL ROOM

All athletes in a specific discipline will enter the stadium together by passing through the Call Room. For detailed information, please refer to the times listed on the Call Room schedule. Clothing, shoes, and bibs will be checked in the Call Room and must comply with Technical Rule 5 of the World Athletics Competition Rules. Advertising and promotional displays on clothing and bags worn within the competition area must comply with the World Athletics Marketing and Advertising Regulations for Invitation Meetings (in effect as of 1 December 2023). In case of non-compliance with the WA Advertising Rules, appearance fees and prize money may be reduced.

#### VICTORY CEREMONY

There will be a victory ceremony for all winners of each discipline. The first one will take place at approx. 2:40 pm and the second one at approx. 3:55 pm. Non-participation at the victory ceremony will cause loss of prize money.

#### **IMPLEMENT CONTROL**

Implements musst be dropped-off at the entrance to the warm-up area (after shuttle drop-off/parking) latest at:

Discus throw men:	10:45am
Shot Put women:	11:15am
Discus Throw women:	12:40pm

Please hand in a maximum of two implements per athlete. You will receive a receipt for each implement you submit. Please keep these receipts to collect your implements after the competition at the Implement Control Room (located next to the mixed zone). Personal implements must not be taken from the competition site.

#### ATHLETES' SECTION

Athletes and Coaches/Managers have access to all public stands with their accreditation. Please make use of free seats.
